The IADIS Multi Conference on Computer Science and Information Systems (MCCSIS 2012) was held in Lisbon, Portugal, 17-23 July, 2012.

This Conference addressed two main subjects: Computer Science and Information Systems. The Multi Conference was organized into fourteen conferences according to several themes and it aimed to cover both technical as well non-technological issues related to developments within Computer Science and Information Systems.
